APPROXIMATELY 1450 L.F. OF 5' WIDE CONCRETE SIDEWALK, PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE, 1310 L.F. OF 2' WIDE CURB AND GUTTER, APPROXIMATELY 540 L.F. OF 15" RCP STORM PIPE, 7 STORM STRUCTURES, 375 S.F. OF CAST IN PLACE RETAINING WALL, ASPHALT PATCHING, STRIPING, GRADING, AND PERMANENT SODDING AND SEEDING.

THE BRACKET ESTIMATE ON THIS PROJECT IS FROM \$450,000 TO \$550,000. THIS BRACKET RANGE IS SHOWN ONLY TO PROVIDE GENERAL FINANCIAL INFORMATION TO CONTRACTORS AND BONDING COMPANIES CONCERNING THE PROJECT'S COMPLEXITY AND SIZE. THIS BRACKET SHOULD NOT BE USED IN PREPARING A BID, NOR WILL THIS BRACKET HAVE ANY BEARING ON THE DECISION TO AWARD THE CONTRACT. THE PRINCIPAL ITEMS OF WORK ARE APPROXIMATELY AS FOLLOWS:

IT IS NOT REQUIRED THAT A CONTRACTOR BE LICENSED IN ORDER TO SUBMIT A BID; HOWEVER, PRIOR TO AWARD OF A CONTRACT, PROPER PROOF OF ALL APPLICABLE LICENSURES MUST BE PROVIDED BY THE CONTRACTOR. PROOF OF INSURANCE COVERAGES OF THE TYPES AND AMOUNTS AS SET FORTH IN THE PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS WILL BE REQUIRED OF THE CONTRACTOR, AND ANY AND ALL SUBCONTRACTORS, PRIOR TO BEGINNING WORK. THIS PROJECT IS SUBJECT TO THE CONTRACT WORK HOURS AND SAFETY STANDARDS ACT AND ITS IMPLEMENTING REGULATIONS.
