

## LEGAL NOTICE

### AMENDMENT #16 TO THE CITY OF TUSCALOOSA'S 2013 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR DISASTER RECOVERY ACTION PLAN

The City of Tuscaloosa desires to make the following amendments to the 2013 Community Development Block Grant for Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan that was previously approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The amendment to the Action Plan includes the reallocation of funds within the Round 4 and Round 5 funding timelines which shall be considered non-substantial amendments as well as the creation of Round 9 which will be considered a substantial amendment. With the amendment to the Action Plan, \$33,704,563.00 in projects will be funded.

In the Round 4 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reduce the Juanita Drive activity by \$576,375.49

Increase the Technology Infrastructure activity in the amount of \$576,375.49

In the Round 5 funding cycle, the following amendments shall be made:

Reduce the Alberta Technology Public Library activity by \$500,000

Add the Juanita Drive activity in the amount of \$500,000

Create a Round 9 funding cycle and allocate funds as follows:

Allocate \$701,027 to the Alberta Park activity

Allocate \$76,736 to the Juanita Drive activity

Allocate \$50,000 to the Technology Infrastructure activity

Allocate \$8,188 to the IT Server Room activity
