

Amendment #1: The City of Tuscaloosa made an addition to its Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery Action Plan, a comprehensive plan the City of Tuscaloosa created to outline the recovery projects funded through a Community Development Block Grant for Disaster Recovery.

Under the advisement of HUD representatives, costs for environmental reviews originally budgeted to Planning will be moved to individual projects to cover the individual costs associated with performing environmental reviews. Action Plan changes can be found within the detailed description for each project as well as a table outlining the budgets for each project. The table below provides information concerning the re-allocation of funds.
